October 16, 2017

### Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Kirby, Tamara (Skamania County), Adam (Prosecuting Attorney), Sargent Taylor, Chief Bond (Sheriff's Office), Mark (Skamania County EMS), Jeff (Beacon)

- Introductions
- Follow up items from previous meetings
  - Jeff inquire about Clark County's jail/dispatch/CIT training, is there a train the trainers model? CIT
  - Corrections occurring this week/meeting with staff scheduled for next week
  - Jeff contact CRESA to set up a call or invite to next meeting to review Skamania's procedures – Contact has not been made, Skamania County Sheriff uses own staff for operation of 911 dispatch, current process to be reviewed
  - Kirby invite EMS – Done/attending current meeting
  - Further discussion of law enforcement response and CRESA routing at next meeting
- Following meeting last month Sheriff's Department has been reviewing procedure for community response to behavioral health crisis – The members spent time this month in review of current process including the following key points:
  - Current dispatch process for community contact with 911
  - Potential value in use of Southwest Washington Crisis line in supporting current dispatch process
  - Procedure review of other areas law enforcement agencies including Vancouver Police Department, Clark County Sheriff, and Portland area agencies.
  - Differentiating response by EMS and Sheriff in relation to medical emergency versus behavioral health emergency
  - Future planning for possible change in response and ensuring appropriate referral to behavioral health services
- Frequency of Crisis Collaborative – 1 x monthly for 1 hour, will recur the third Monday of each month. Next meeting scheduled for Monday November 20<sup>th</sup> at 1pm
- Follow up items
  - Sheriff to continue reviewing/updating internal policy for response to behavioral health crises.
  - Prosecuting Attorney to review policy on response for Vancouver Police Department and Clark County Sheriff in comparison to current Skamania County Sheriff policy
  - Sargent Taylor request CRESA response policy
  - Jeff to contact CRESA for information related to process in SWWA
  - Jeff to follow up with Clark County Jail regarding current CIT training and potential for providing training to Skamania County Jail staff.
